

1. Introduction

Dioxin (DXN) discharged from a variety of industrial processes such as waste incineration and electric power generation has become a social problem in recent years, and countermeasures have been demanded. Among methods of reducing DXN in waste incineration, the most ideal method is the introduction of activated carbon injection, but activated carbon adsorption of dioxin is being adopted to measure dioxin emission standards. However, the conventional activated carbon adsorption of dioxin is largely in scale, and because the dioxin concentration in the gas is of combustible activated carbon, ignition is an important measure. For these reasons, application has been limited to some waste incineration.
